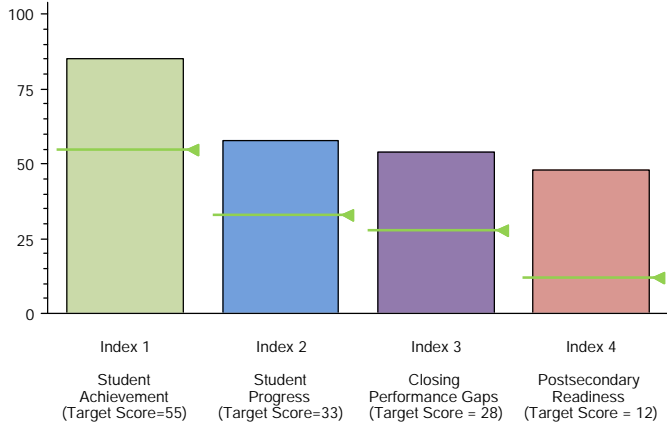

Met Standard

State accountability ratings are based on four performance indexes: Student Achievement, Student Progress, Closing Performance Gaps, and Postsecondary Readiness. The bar chart below illustrates the index scores (ranging from 0 to 100) for this campus for a given index. The Target Score -- the score required to meet each index's standard -- is indicated below the index description and as a line on each bar. In order to receive the accountability rating, the campus must have met or exceeded the target score on each index evaluated.

For 2014 state accountability, campuses are rated as Met Standard, or Not Met Standard. The rating, Met Standard, is assigned to charters and alternative education campuses evaluated under alternative education accountability (AEA) provisions.

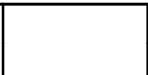
