

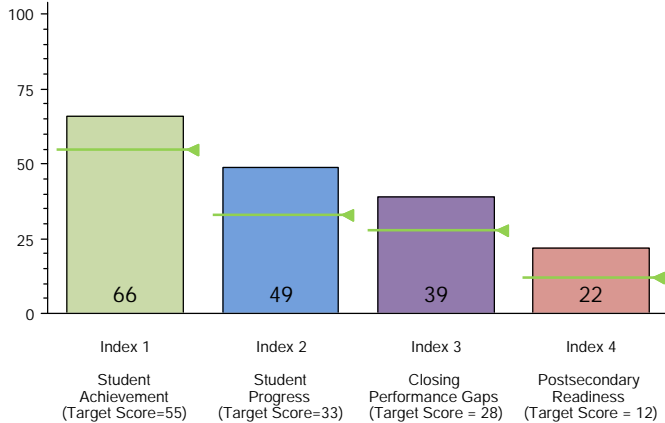

2014 Performance Index

State accountability ratings are based on four performance indexes: Student Achievement, Student Progress, Closing Performance Gaps, and Postsecondary Readiness. The bar chart below illustrates the index scores (ranging from 0 to 100) for this campus for a given index. The Target Score -- the score required to meet each index's standard -- is indicated below the index description and as a line on each bar. Distinction Designations

Science

Campuses that receive a rating of Met Standard are eligible for seven distinction designations: Academic Achievement in Reading/English Language Arts (ELA), Academic Achievement in Mathematics, Academic Achievement in Science, Academic Achievement in Social Studies, Top 25%: Student Progress, Top 25%: Closing Performance Gaps, and Postsecondary Readiness.
