Austin Independent School District ("AISD") requests proposals for a Contractor to perform the construction of the Work described below in connection with AISD's Renovations at Project (the "Project"). AISD is interested in receiving proposals from General Contractors with experience in successfully completing projects that are similar in scope, size and complexity to the Work and meeting any specialized requirements set forth below.

If AISD is unable to negotiate a satisfactory contract with the selected Offeror, AISD shall, formally and in writing, end negotiations with that Offeror and proceed to the next Offeror in the order of the selection ranking until a contract is reached or all proposals are rejected. AISD reserves the right to reject any and all proposals. Consistent with state law and district policy, this RFP does not commit the district to award a contract. The district reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals and/or award in whole or in part any proposal if the district determines it is in the best interest of the district to do so.
