Subsection (b) states "a school district may terminate a contract with a person or business entity if the district deternines that the person or business entity failed to give notice as require Subsection (a) or misrepresented the conduct resulting in the conviction. The distric compensate the person or business entity for services performed before the termoinable contract".
