Rising sixth- and ninth-grade students from every campus will be recruited based on diversity standards to ensure equity, access and inclusion. The Austin ISD Human Capital and Equity Offices will serve as a coaching and consultative resource to ensure magnet campuses are supported in meeting the new standards.
