Results

Coordinated School Health (CSH) Program implementation data were collected from each Austin Independent School District (AISD) campus in Spring 2018. Campus results will be reflected in the District's strategic plan scorecard and in AISD's Local Accountability System (LAS), established under House Bill 22 of the 85th Texas Legislature.

Schools were rated on their Coordinated School Health Implementation on a 4 point scale (Unacceptable, Acceptable, Recognized, or Exemplary) based on identified activities that support coordinate d school health efforts. The rating scale was different at each level¹, based on the overall number of required and supplemental activities available at each level.
