


The average ACT composite score of 21.5 was attirate high for the district and exceeded the state and national average composite scores.altional average composite scores decreased in 2013, and the state average composite score remainablout the same, compared with scores the prior yelarapress releaseACT 2013a, ACT officials attributed the decrease in the national average composite score to updated standards and more students taking the exams. Dissimilarly, average composite scores for AISD students have increased along with rates of student test participation (Figure 3).
