
Figure 3. AISD, State, and National Overall Average ACT Scores, 220095-

Over thepast 5 years, the district's average ACT composites core and subject area scores English, rath, reading, and science increased for all student groups, except for Asian udent scores reading and math. Although the average ACT reading d maths cores for Asian students lecreased during this period, their average score exceeded that of most other groups. In comparison with stypes, African American and Hispanic students had creased average scores in all four bject areas in 2014. While Ascores increased over the years for most student groups, achievement groups (Figures Brough 11).

In 2014, students who categorized emselves as Hispanic, Whiteor "two or more races" had greater average composite score on the ACT compared with their peers at the state and national levels. African American students in AISD had greater average composite score than students nationide. The average composite score on the ACT for Asian students in A(30.4) alsowas greater than their counterparts at the national lev(Figure 12).
