# HIGH SCHOOL EXIT SURVEY REPORT FOR CLASS OF 2009, BOWIE HIGH S

Surveying the post contains the relies for the Bowie High School Class of 2009. Where available the Surveying the post data are presented to compare with 2009 responses. In addition, average reall AISD high schools are presented alongside results for Bowie for comparison purposes. In 3,365 students in the Class of 2009 completed the survey, including 547 students from Bowie Longitudinal tests for statistical gnificance were conducted with dirict-level data (see dislevel report). Figure 2. Now Indicate The Number Of Hours Per Week That You Have Worked During Your Senior Year. (Q18b)




Figure 3. Thinking Back On Your Years In High School, How Many Hours Per Week Did You Typically Spend Studying, Doing Research, Or Completing Homework Assignments Outside Of Class? (Item 19)



Figure 9a. What Is The *One Thing* That Was Most Important To Keeping You Going Through School All The Way To Graduation? (Item 48, Bowie)




Figure 9b. What Is The *One Thing* That Was Most Important To Keeping You Going Through School All The Way To Graduation? (Item 48, All High Schools)
