The federal Title IV Safe and Drug Free Sclscomd Communities grant requires annual needs assessment and evaluation of substance use and isstues. Consequently, each year, a self-report student survey of substance use and school safedynishistered to a random, representative sample of AISD students. The survey is used to track studenowledge, attitudes a self-reported behavior over time. How should sample data be interpreted?








Q21: Do teachers or staff give youajse or rewards for good behavior?








Q10: During this school year, whe you experienced any of the lowing types of bullying at school?






Q11: How big a problem do you thinbullying is at your school?



Q9: During this school year, how often have you your close friends been physically harmed or threatened with physical harm by other student at your school?










Q25:What is the most recent you have used


Q27:What is the most recent you have used Inhtal things you might iffn, such as glue, paint, gasoline, white out, etc.)?




Q42: During this year, how often did you use **liaintes** (things you might sniff, such as glue, paint, gasoline, white out, etc.)?




Q55: How dangerous is it for kids your age te **us**halants (things you mightiff, such as glue, paint, gasoline, white out, etc.)?



Q28:What is the most recent you have used **Orver**Counter Medicatin (e.g., triple Cs, DXM, skittles, or Coricidin) to get high?





Q43: During this year, how often did you uger the Counter Medication (e.g., triple Cs, DXM, skittles, or Coricidin) to get high?
