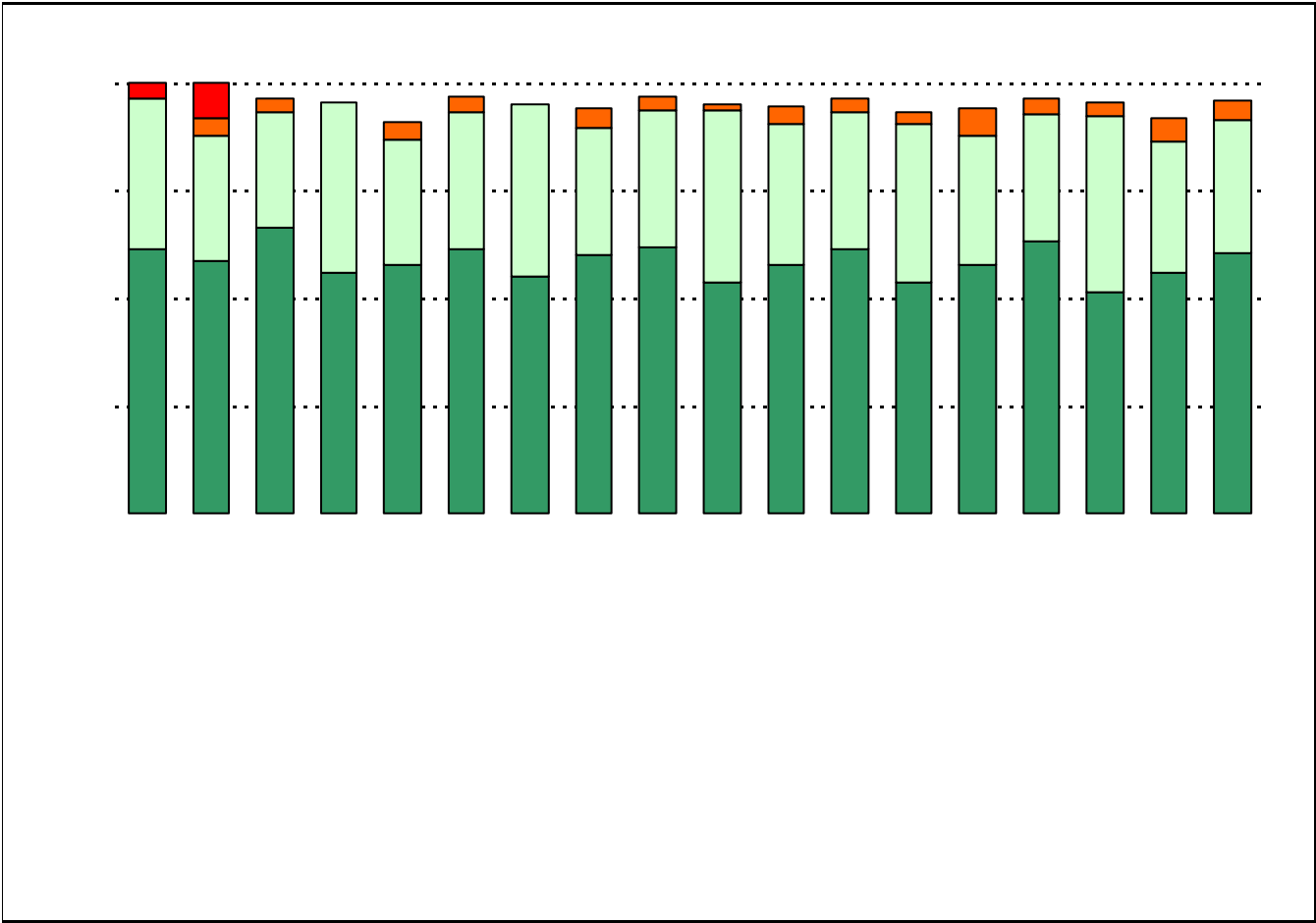

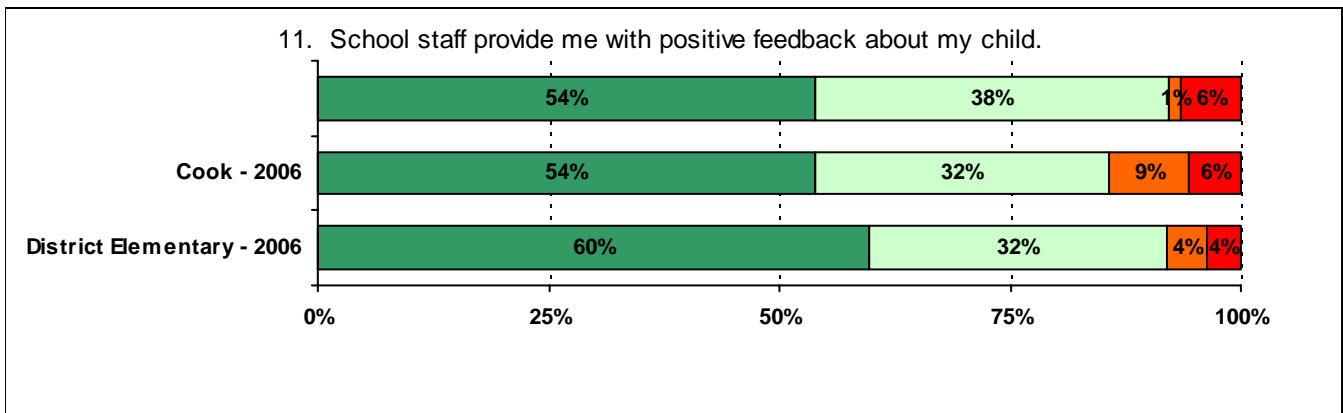
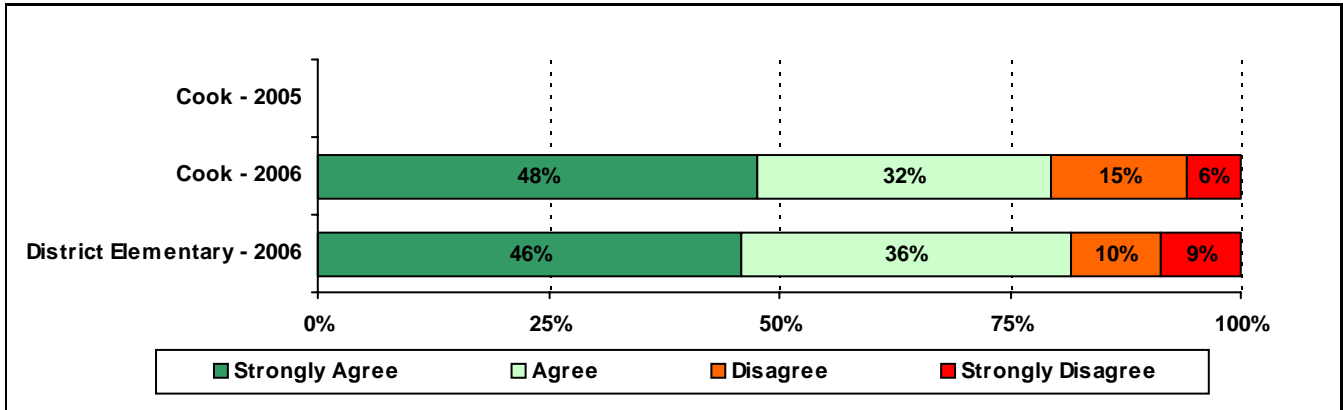

USING THE RESULTS OF THE AISD PARENT SURVEY

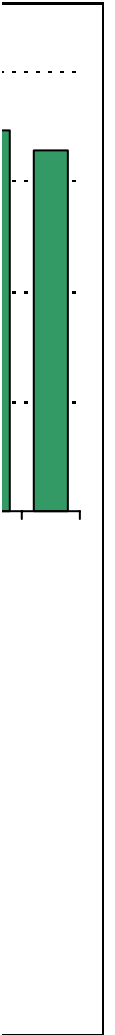
Each survey item is presented below, followed by a bar graph containing your school's results for two years and this year's results for all campuses at your level. You will be able to identify areas

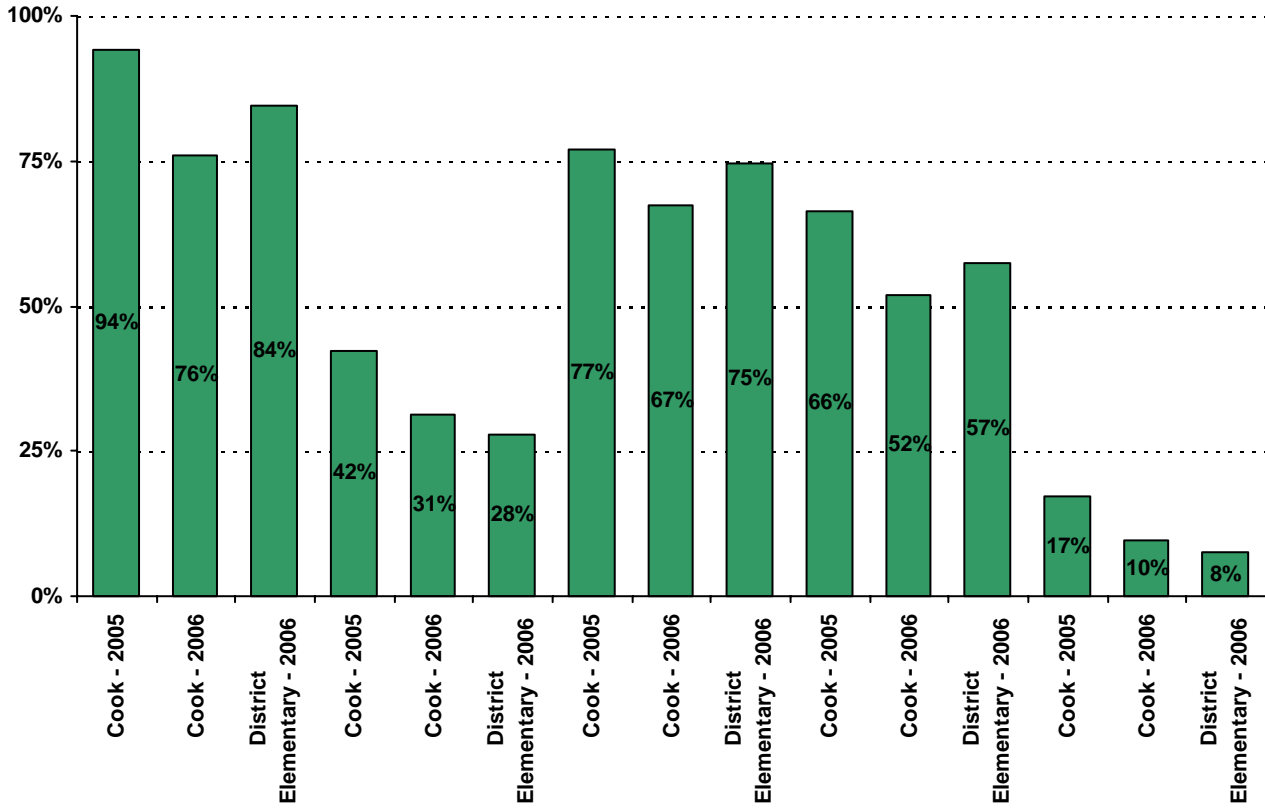
