




Q14: How often does racitension occur at your school?



Q17: How often do gang actives occur at your school?




Q18: How often have you experience type of bullying at your school?





Q19: How often were you absent because did unot feel safe on the way to/from school?




Q20: How often does your teacher have to interclass to deal with student misbehavior?

Q7: How safe do you feel when you are at school?



Q11: How big a problem do you thinbullying is at your school?




Q9: During this school year, how often have you close friends been physically harmed or threatened with physical harm by other student at your school?












