Themes from this open-ended comment section have been identified and summarized each year. Generally, comments remain consistent from year to year; commonly identified themes expressed by the Class of 2007 include:

Respect. Students continued to express a desire to be treated with respect and fairness by school staff, including administrators, office/attendance staff, hall monitors, security and parking lot personnel. Many felt that they were treated with suspicion and disrespect as a result of the behavior of other students. Students also were concerned that some rules (e.g., parking, dress code, off-campus lunch) were enforced inconsistently. **Academics**
