Description of Survey

The federal Title IV Safe and Drug Free Sclsoand Communities grant requires annual needs assessment and evaluation of substance use and isalues. Consequently, each year, a self-report student survey of substance use and school safedynishistered to a random, representative sample of AISD students. The survey is used to track studenowledge, attitudesnal self-reported behavior over time. In the Spring of 2008 a sample of 8,43.6dents in grades 6-12 submitted valid responses to the district's annual survey of substance use safety issues, yielding a response rate of 738elected item results are attached. 




Q17: How often do gang actives occur at your school?




Q18: How often have you experience type of bullying at your school?




Q20: How often does your teacher have to interclass to deal with student misbehavior?



Q21: Do teachers or staff give youajsre or rewards for good behavior?





Q28:What is the most recent you have used **Ofwer**Counter Medicatin (e.g., triple Cs, DXM, skittles, or Coricidin) to get high?


