For the 1999-2000 school year, **Houston Elementary** received one additional **first** grade teacher due to Class Size Reduction, a federally funded grants program (Title VI, Public Law 105-

During the **1998-99** school year:

- There were ten 1st grade classes;
- The smallest 1st grade class had 17 students;
- The largest 1st grade class had 21 students;
- On average, 1st grade classes had **19** students.

During the 1999-2000 school year:

- There were eight 1st grade classes;
- The smallest 1st grade class had 14 students;
- The largest 1st grade class had 21 students;
- On average, 1st grade classes had 16 students.

- Sixty-four percent of **first** grade students at **Houston Elementary** scored at or above grade level on the Reading Comprehension portion of the Primary Assessment of Language Arts and Mathematics (PALM) in April, 2000.
- PALM data were not available from the district for April, 1999.
