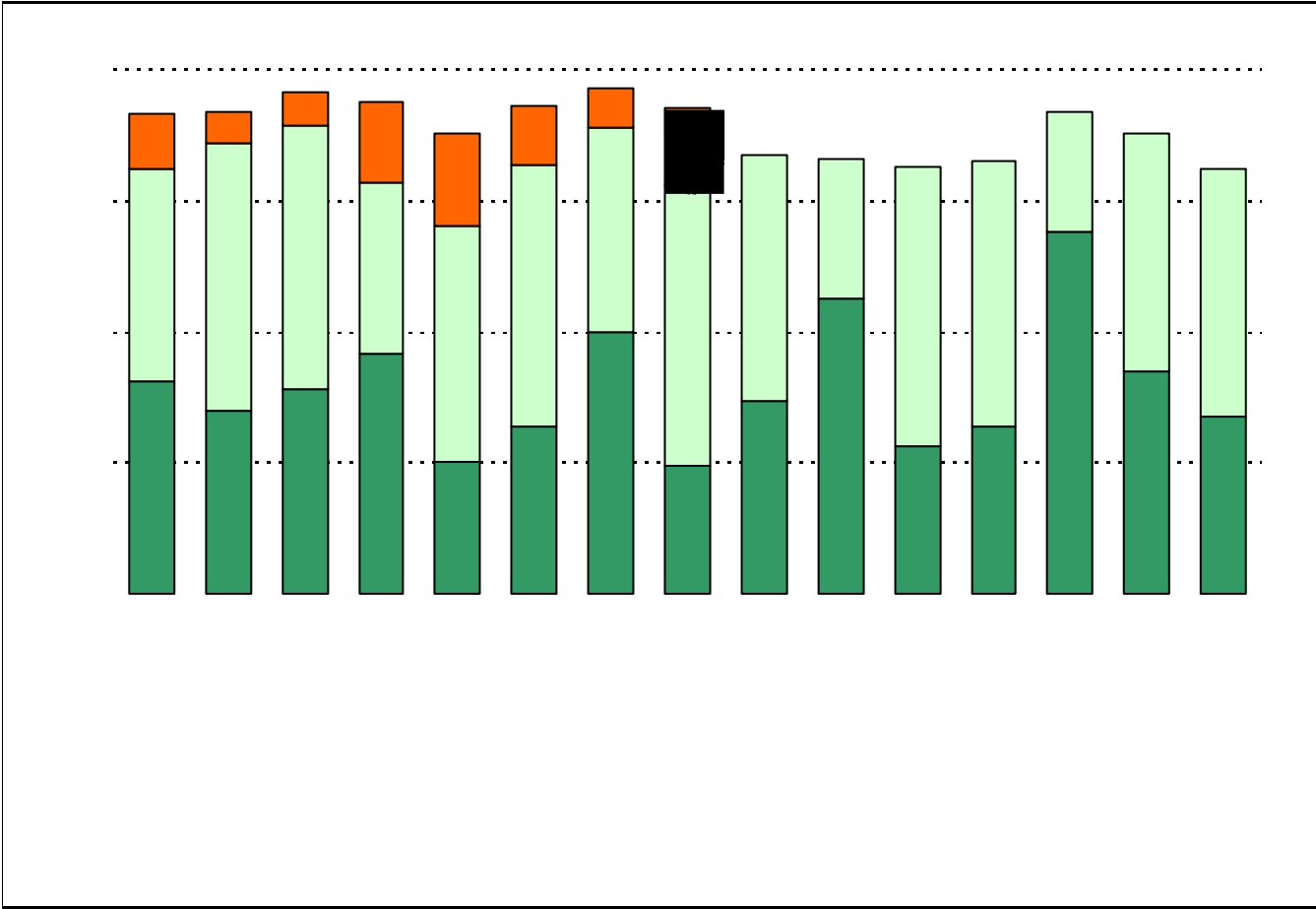


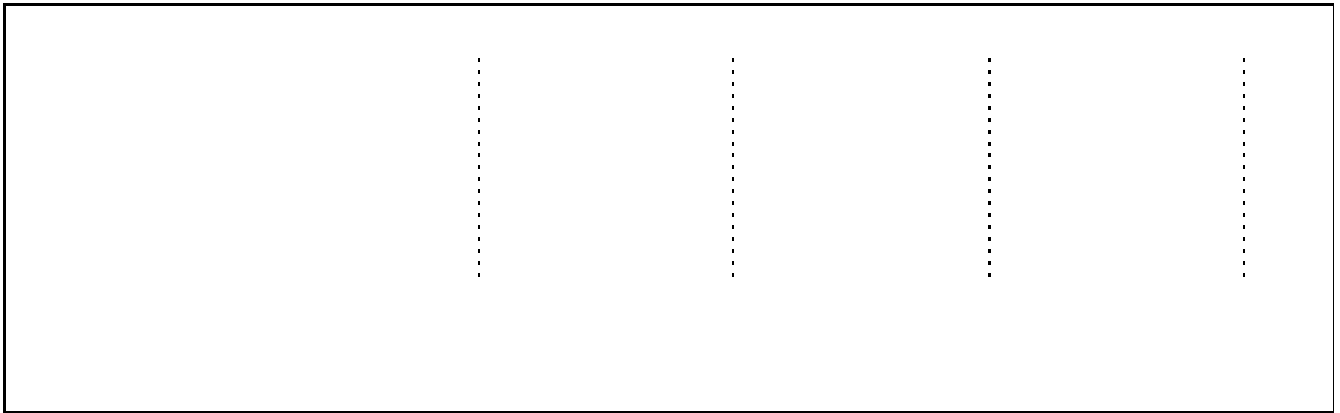
**How many parents responded to the survey in 2004-2005 and 2005-2006, and how does this compare to the number of students in the population each year?**

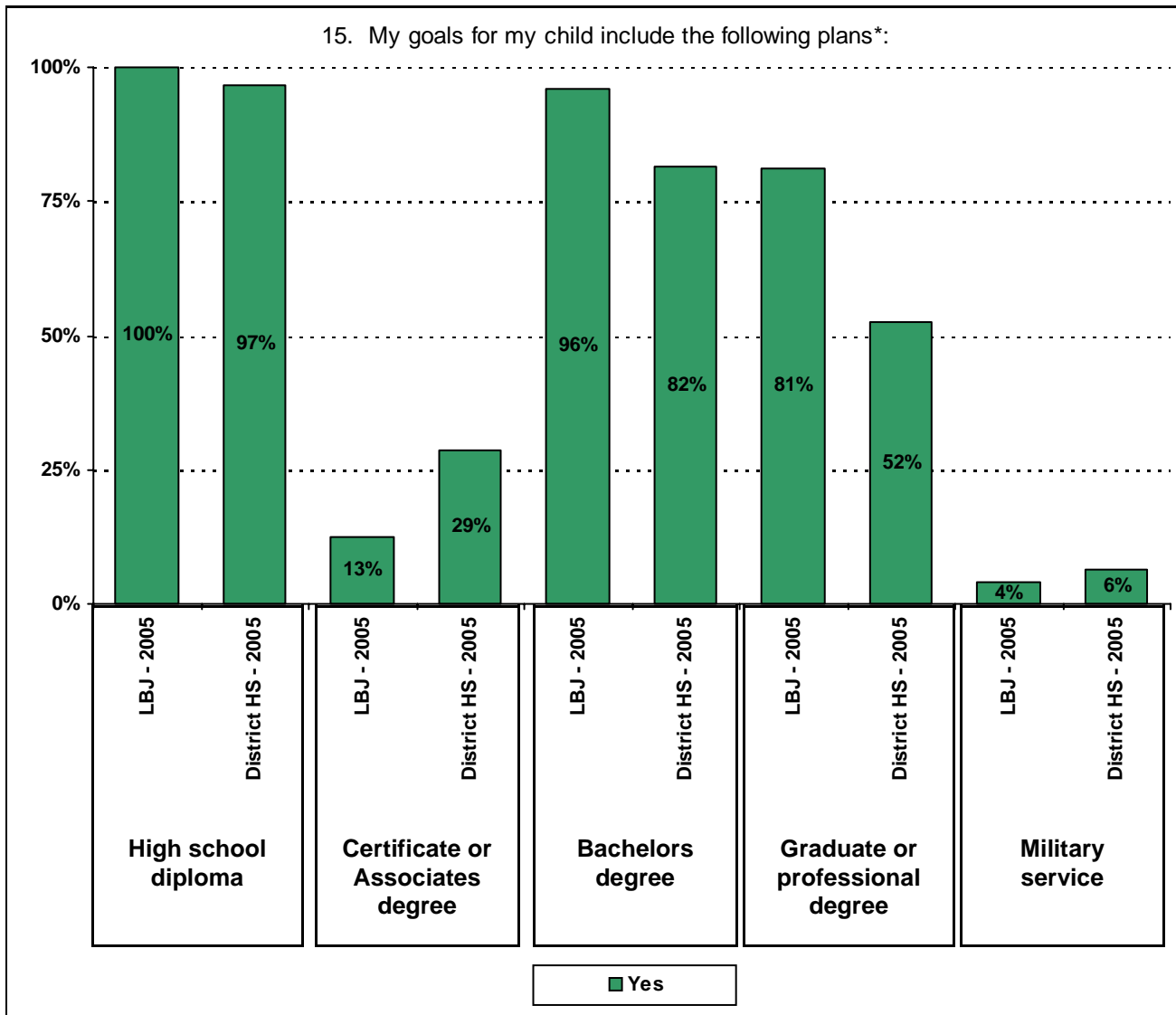


\* The "Parent/Family Involvement Opportunities" and "Parent/Family Resources" categories were added to the survey in 2005.
