Figure 1. Now Indicate The Number Of Hours Per Week That You Have Worked During Last Summer. (Q18a)




Figure 2. Now Indicate The Number Of Hours Per Week That You Have Worked During Your Senior Year. (Q18b)




Figure 3. Thinking Back On Your Years In High School, How Many Hours Per Week Did You Typically Spend Studying, Doing Research, Or Completing Homework Assignments Outside Of Class? (Item 19)




Figure 4. On Average, What Percentage Of Your Study, Research And Homework Was Done Without Distractions (E.G., Television, Music, IM, Texting, Phone Calls)? (Item 20)



Figure 8. How Many Siblings (Brothers Or Sisters) Do You Have Who Are Either Enrolled In College Or Live With You (Item 11)



Figure 9a. What Is The One ThingThat Was Most Important To Keeping You Going Through School All The Way To Graduation? (Item 48, McCallum)




Figure 9b. What Is The One ThingThat Was Most Important To Keeping You Going Through School All The Way To Graduation? (Item 48, All High Schools)
