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RESULTS OF THE 2008STUDENT SUBSTANCE USE AND SAFETY SURVEY

O. HENRY MIDDLE SCHOOL

Description of Survey

The federal Title IV Safe and Drug Free Sciscophid Communities grant requires annual needs assessment and evaluation of substance use articles. Consequently, each year, a self-report student survey of substance use and school safetyministered to a random, representative sample of AISD students. The survey is used to track studenowledge, attitudes a self-reported behavior over time. In the Spring of 2008 a sample of 8,436dents in grades 6-12 submitted valid responses to the district's annual survey of substance used eafety issues, yielding a response rate of 58dected item results are attached. - 3/4 Desired level of confidence: In this case, 95%.







Q11: How big a problem do you thinbullying is at your school?




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






Q12: Are school rules about drug, alcohold aobacco use enforced by school staff?
