Description of Survey

The federal Title IV Safe and Drug Free Schood Communities grant requires annual needs assessment and evaluation of substance use and isafues. Consequently, each year, a self-report student survey of substance use and school safed is is students. The survey is used to track studen owledge, attitudes a self-reported behavior over time. In the Spring of 2008 a sample of 8,43.0 dents in grades 6-12 submitted valid responses to the district's annual survey of substance use a afety issues, yielding a response rate of #39 elected item results are attached. How should sample data be interpreted?



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



Q18: How often have you experience dy type of bullying at your school?




Q19: How often were you absent because didunot feel safe on the way to/from school?








Q21: Do teachers or staff give youajse or rewards for good behavior?




Q7: How safe do you feel when you are at school?








Q39: During this year, how often did you ulsebacco (e.g., cigarettes, cigars, chew, etc)?




Q26:What is the most recent you have used Maria (e.g., pot, weed, joint, blunt, etc.)?




Q27:What is the most recent you have used Inhtal things you might iffn, such as glue, paint, gasoline, white out, etc.)?



Q42: During this year, how often did you use **liaintes** (things you might sniff, such as glue, paint, gasoline, white out, etc.)?





Q55: How dangerous is it for kids your age te **us**halants (things you mightiff, such as glue, paint, gasoline, white out, etc.)?









Q37: During this school year, have you gotteto inouble with the police because of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol?
