

#### TRAVIS HIGH SCHOOL

The sixth annual AISD High School Exit Survey was administered online<sup>1</sup> to seniors in every AISD High School during the Spring of 2008. This report contains the results for the Travis High School Class of 2008. Where available, longitudinal data and the average results from all AISD high schools are presented alongside results for Travis for comparison purposes. In total, 3,192 students in the Class of 2008 completed the survey, including 208 students from Travis. Longitudinal tests for statistical significance were conducted with district-level data (see district-level report).

Figure 9. How Helpful Was Your School Counselor in the Following Types of Meetings? (Item 41)


