Description of Survey


The federal Title IV Safe and Drug Free Sclsoand Communities grant requires annual needs assessment and evaluation of substance use and isatues. Consequently, each year, a self-report student survey of substance use and school safedynishistered to a random, representative sample of AISD students. The survey is used to track studenowledge, attitudesnal self-reported behavior over time. In the Spring of 2008 a sample of 8,436dents in grades 6-12 submitted valid responses to the district's annual survey of substance use safety issues, yielding a response rate of 738elected item results are attached. 




Q11: How big a problem do you thinbullying is at your school?







Q43: During this year, how often did you (Ger the Counter Medication (e.g., triple Cs, DXM, skittles, or Coricidin) to get high?




Q56: How dangerous is it for kids your ageute Over the Counter Missation (e.g., triple Cs, DXM, skittles, or Coricidin) to get high?






