Title VI, Class Size Reduction Annual Report Card for Zavala Elementary

For the 1999-2000 school year, **Zavala Elementary** received one additional **third** grade teacher due to Class Size Reduction, a federally funded grants program (Title VI, Public Law 105-277). The goal of this program is to reduce class size in grades 1-3 to 18 or fewer students, so that teachers

The percentage of **third** grade students who passed **TAAS Reading** *decreased* from **85%** to **76%** between 1998-99 and 1999-2000 at **Zavala** Elementary.

The percentage of third grade students who passed TAAS Mathematics decreased from 85% to 57% between 1998-99 and 1999-2000 at Zavala Elementary.
