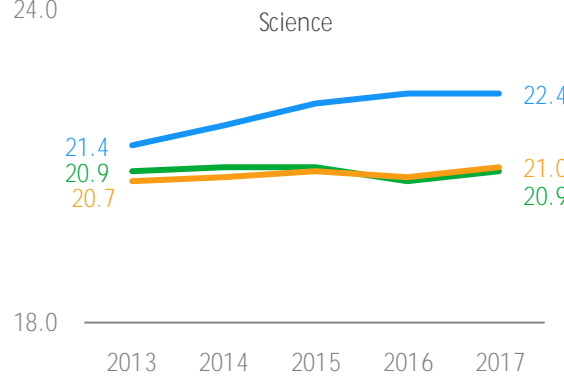
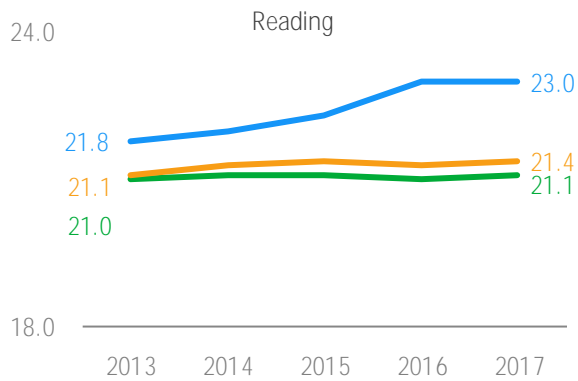
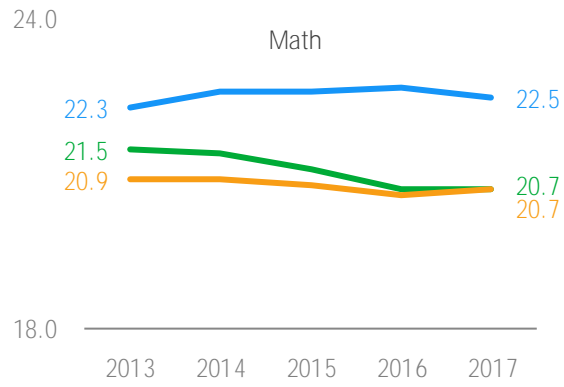
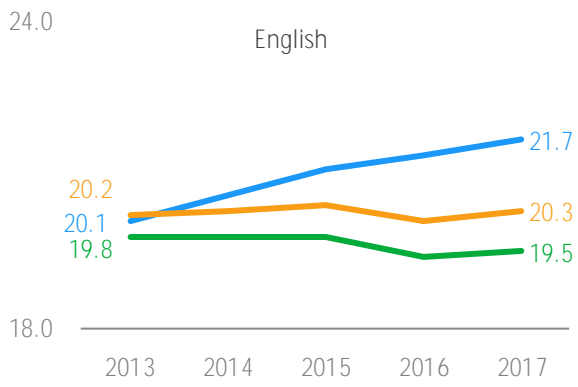
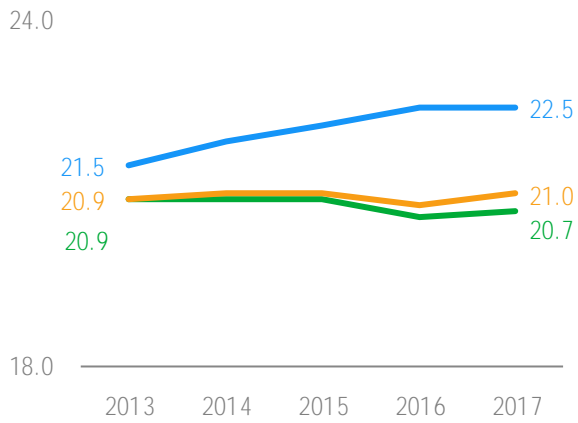
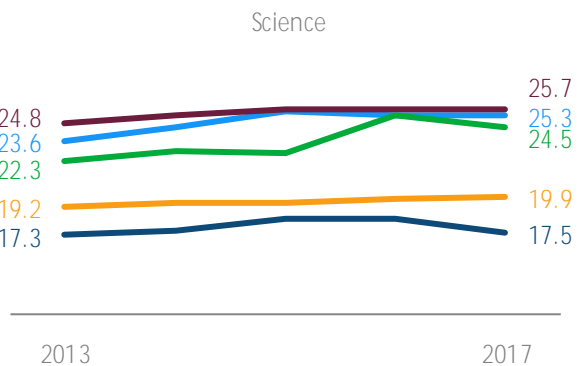
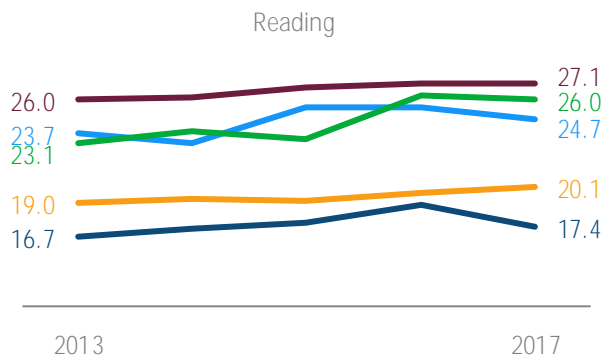
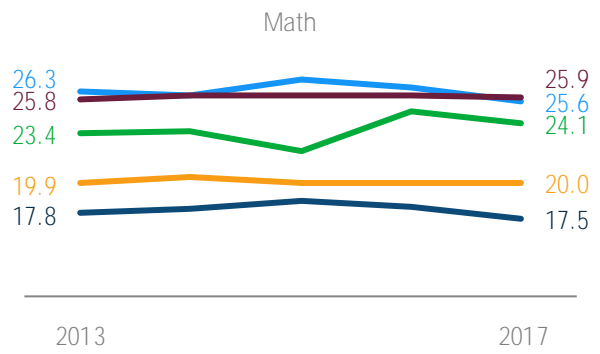
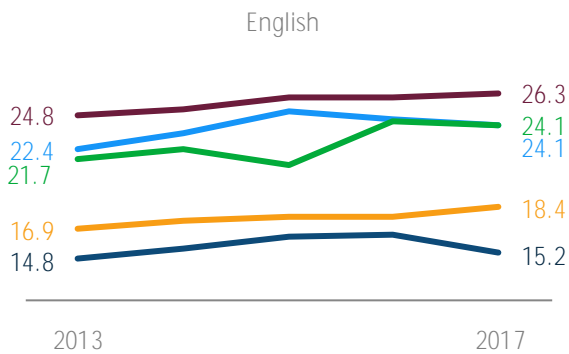
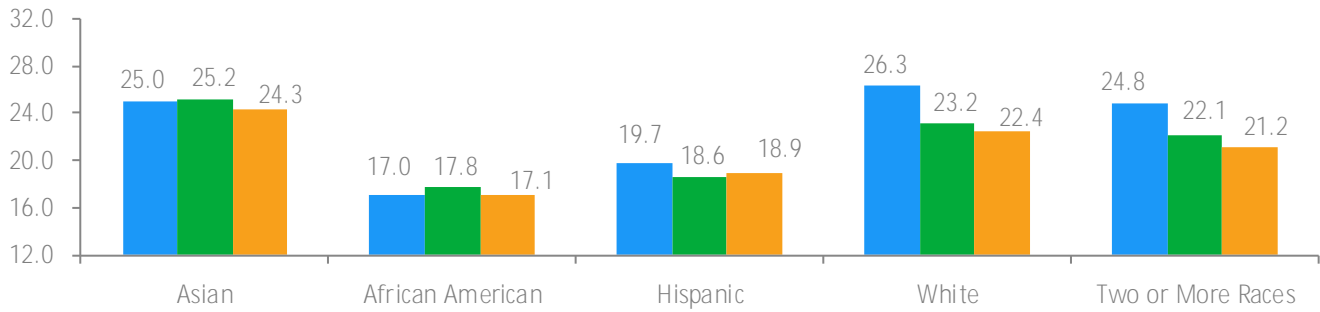




2017 ACT Test Results



With exception of Asian and African-American Students, AISD students had greater average composite scores on the ACT, compared with their peers at the state and national levels (Figure 4). Asian students performed better than their counterparts nationally. Over the past 5 years, the AISD average ACT composite score and subject area scores in English, reading, and science increased in most instances (Figure 5). While ACT scores increased, achievement gaps remained as students who were Asian, two or more races, and White consistently scored higher than did Hispanic and African American students.
