The career and technical education (CTE) program at AISD prepares students to have the academic and technical skills needed for a college education and/or entry-level work in a career pathway. High school students become CTE concentrators by taking two or more courses for three or more credits in a particular career pathway. Each career pathway combines technical training with academics around an industry theme. AISD high schools offer more than 20 CTE career pathways, such as health, manufacturing,
