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How the Secure Web Interface Works

Trained program staff from approved agencian upload files comiting student names, AISD student ID numbers, and school numbers integure web-based interface. SAR-SSP then generates a reptolisting the selected outcomes as well as other descriptive information (grade level, gender, ethnicity, and economic disadvantage). Users also have the option desting a comparison group. The comparison group can either be the same student program participant slifterent point imterior, pre- or post-intervention longitudinal design), or a randomely cted set of students who are matched on user-specified demographic criteria (i.e., cross is secul design). After the comparison group has been chosen, a report is produced whican be exported to either PDF or MS Excel formats.
